Why do we collect information?

Who else will see this information?

Be assured that we will not disclose your personal information to third parties without your consent. However, we reserve the right to disclose user information in special cases when we have reason to believe that disclosing this information is necessary to identify, contact or bring legal action against someone who may be causing injury to or interference with (either intentionally or unintentionally) *Law South Group Ltd's* rights or property, other users, or anyone else who could be harmed by such activities. We also reserve the right to disclose user information when we believe in good faith that the law requires it.

Can you see your information?

Is my information secure?

The personal information which we hold will be held securely in accordance with our internal security policy and the law.
